Who we are & what we do...

The Chronicle Sunshine Fund is a North East based charity that changes the lives of local babies, children and young adults, living with disabilities, additional needs and terminal illness, by funding life-changing and specialist equipment.

The North East has some of the highest numbers of registered disabled children in comparison to the rest of the UK and as our region often faces the biggest cuts in government funding, the equipment we fund cannot be funded by the NHS or local authorities.

We are proud to say that we are not means tested as we believe regardless of a family's financial situation or income, every child with a disability, has the right to have access equipment that can improve their quality of life whilst offering comfort, respite, safety and happiness that ultimately allows them to live life to the full, offering them the opportunities they deserve.

As a small charity, we receive no statutory funding and so we rely solely on the support and generosity of local organisations, communities and individuals to enable us to fund the equipment our children so desperately need. This Christmas is going to be especially difficult for many of our families, with the cost of living crisis and the demand for equipment rapidly growing.

At The Chronicle Sunshine Fund we aim to provide equipment, family support services and inclusive events to ensure all children, regardless of their abilities or prognosis, can live safely, comfortably and have the chance to meet their own individual potential. **But we can't do it alone... we need your help!**
