MEET OLIVIA

16-year-old Oli has Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) which means he uses a wheelchair. Like many teenagers, Oli is sports mad and he especially loves football.

Whilst regularly attending football tournaments (as pictured to the right), he also plays Powered Football for Newcastle United, and he is part of the England development team.

We have supported Oli since he was little and we have seen him gain lots of confidence over the years. His football commitments involve a lot of travelling, and as he grows older, he's determined to become as independent as possible.

For a while, Oli's Dad would lift him in and out of his wheelchair, but this became increasingly difficult and unsafe. To allow Oli to access activities safely, independently, and with dignity, we funded him a mobile hoist, which has made a huge difference to both Oli and his family's lives.
